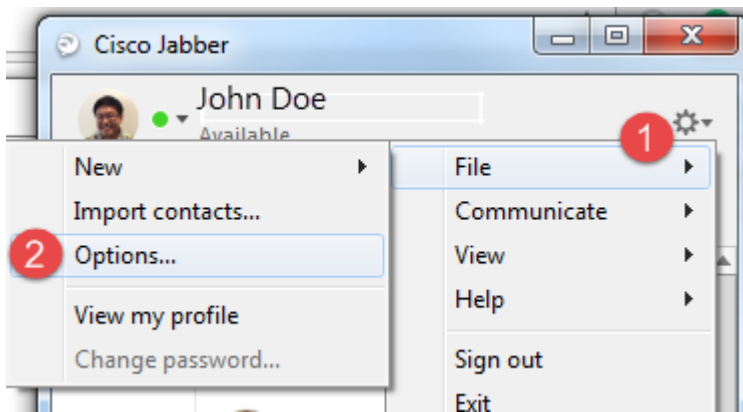

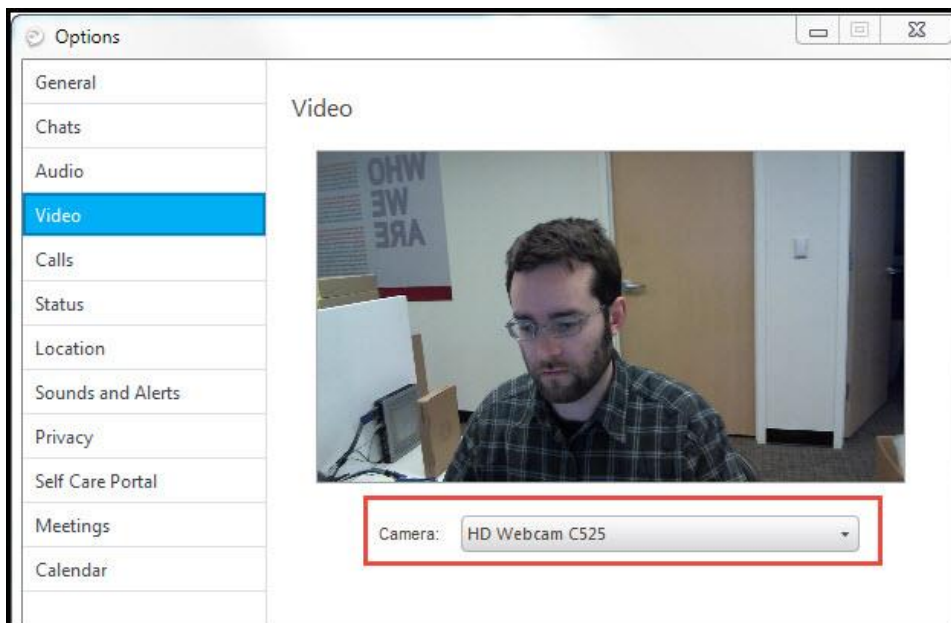
## How Do I Setup a Default Camera in Jabber?

If you have multiple webcams on your computer (a laptop with a built in camera and an external USB camera) you can set the priority of devices in the options menu. Here are the steps to set the priority of your device in Jabber.

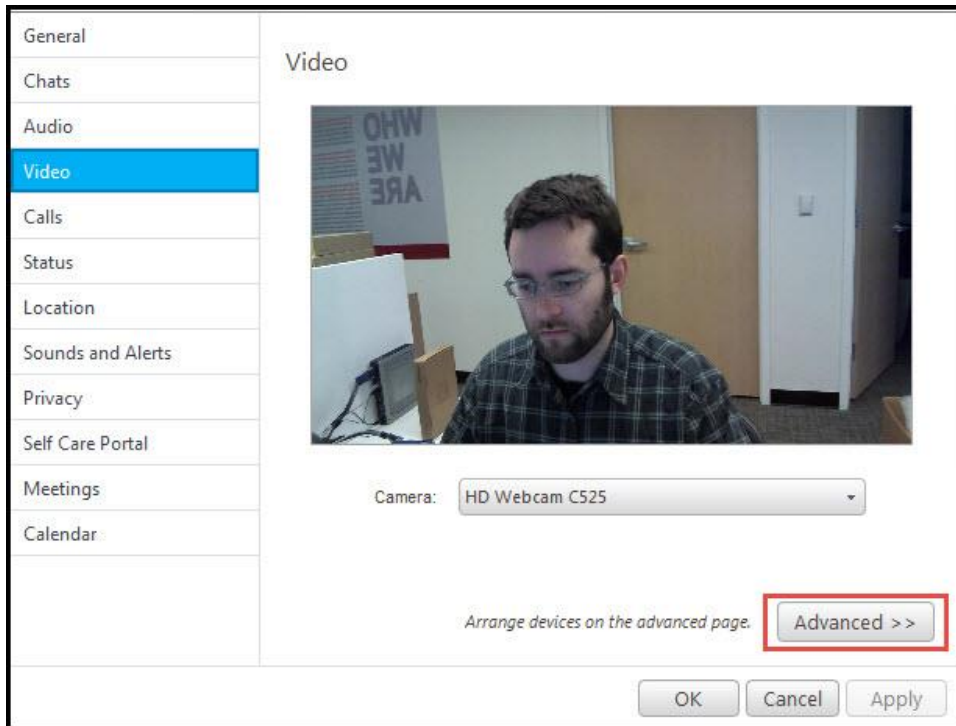
1. Go to the gear icon  and click on **File > Options**.



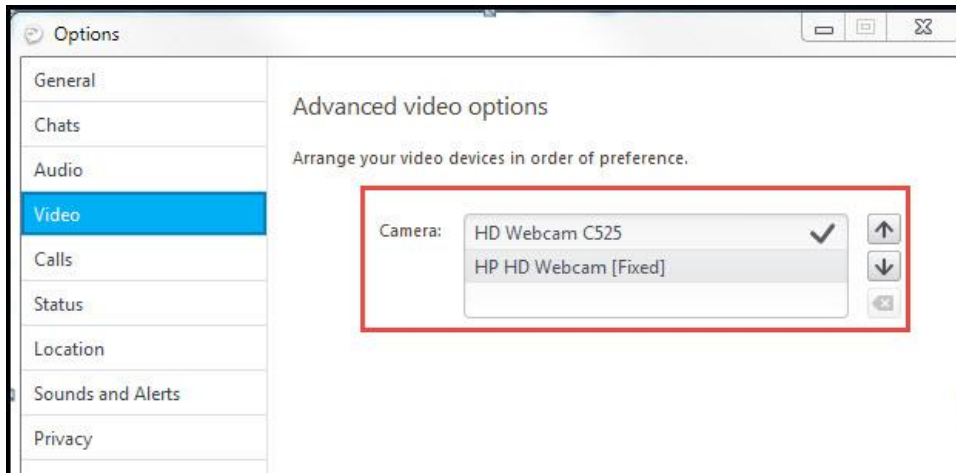
2. Click on the **Video** option in the window. You should see a drop-down listing your cameras under the current video feed, this will allow you to change the currently active camera



3. To permanently change the camera priority press the **Advanced** button in the bottom right:

5. The menu should change to list all devices detected by the client. Simply change the order by selecting the cameras and using the up and down arrows to move the desired default camera to the top of the list.



6. Click **Apply** and **OK** once finished.
