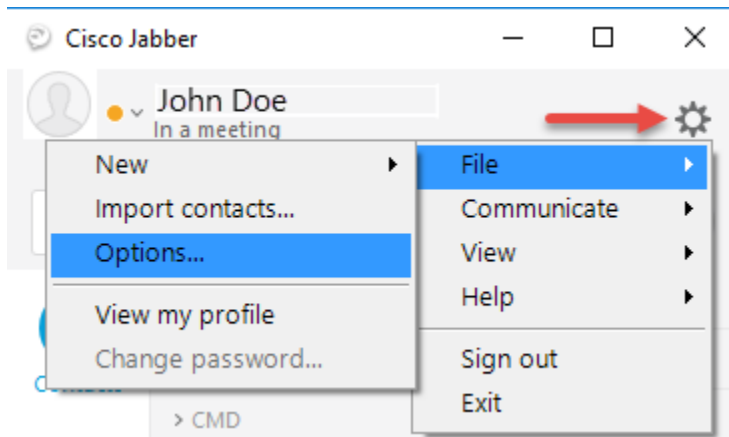

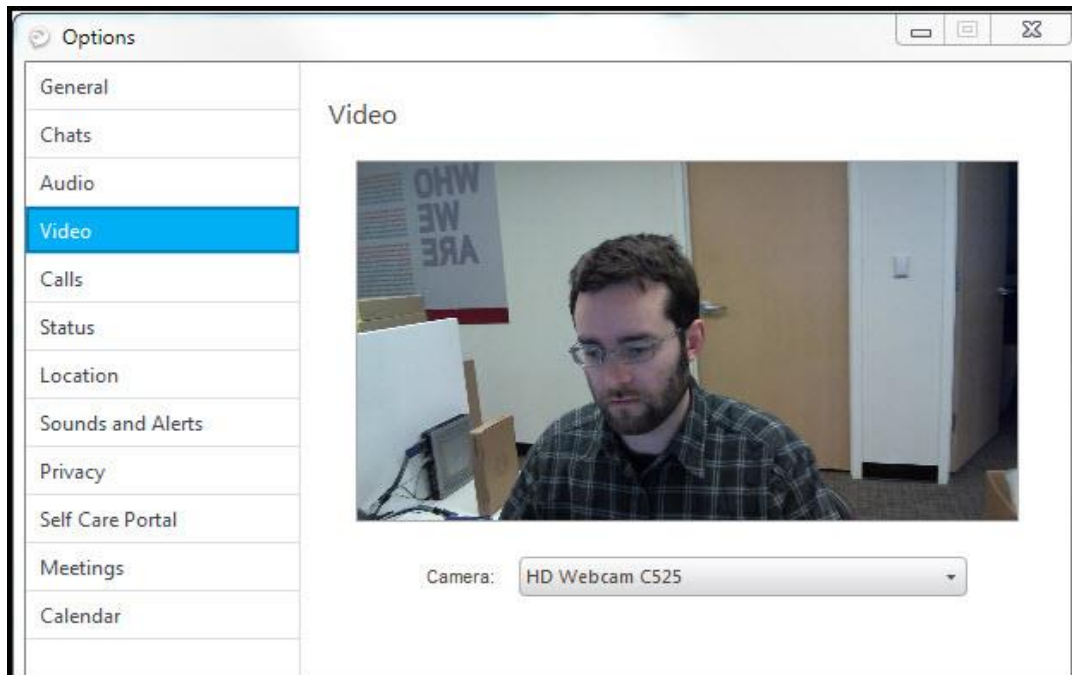
How do I Place a Video Call in Jabber?

Before placing a call in Jabber using video, make sure your web camera and a headset (with microphone) are properly connected to your computer.

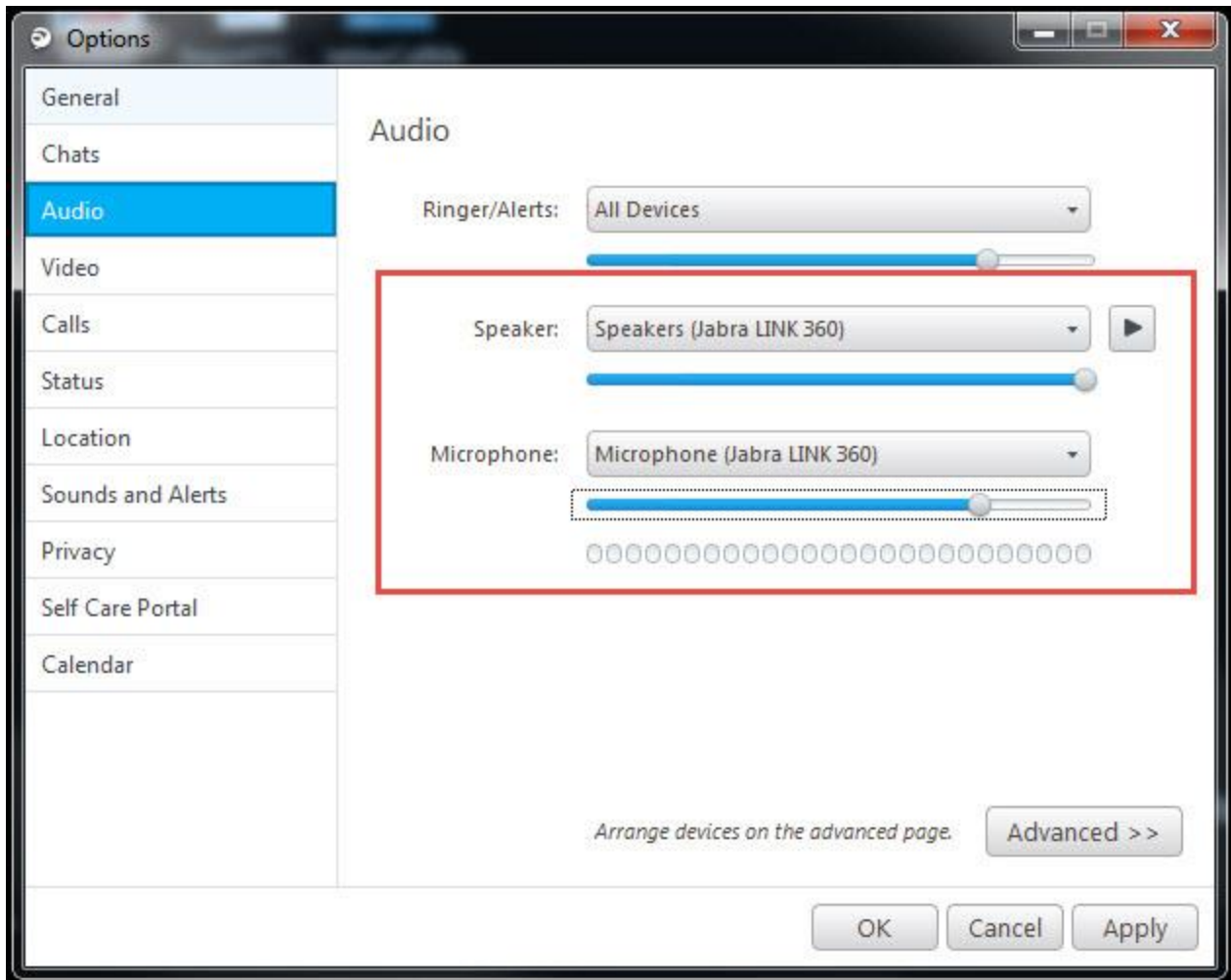
1. Go to the **gear icon** and choose **File** and then **Options**.



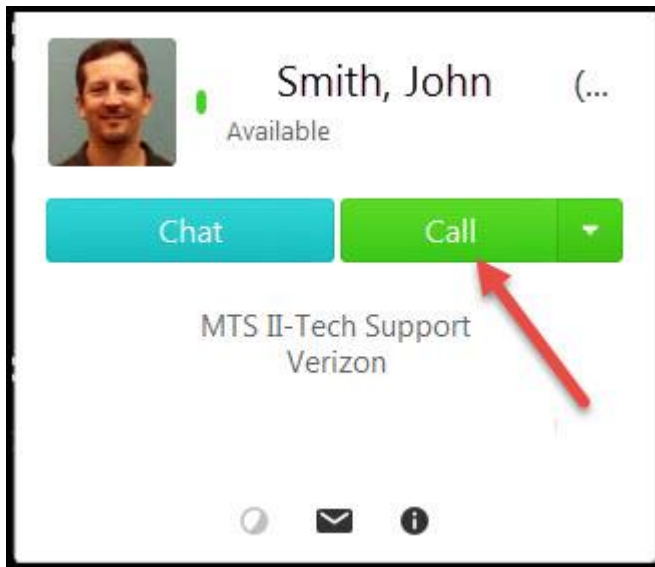
2. Click on the **Video** option in the window. If you see a **No Camera found** message, this means the camera is not connected properly. Reconnect your camera and make sure you can see yourself in the video self-view. Click **OK** when finished.



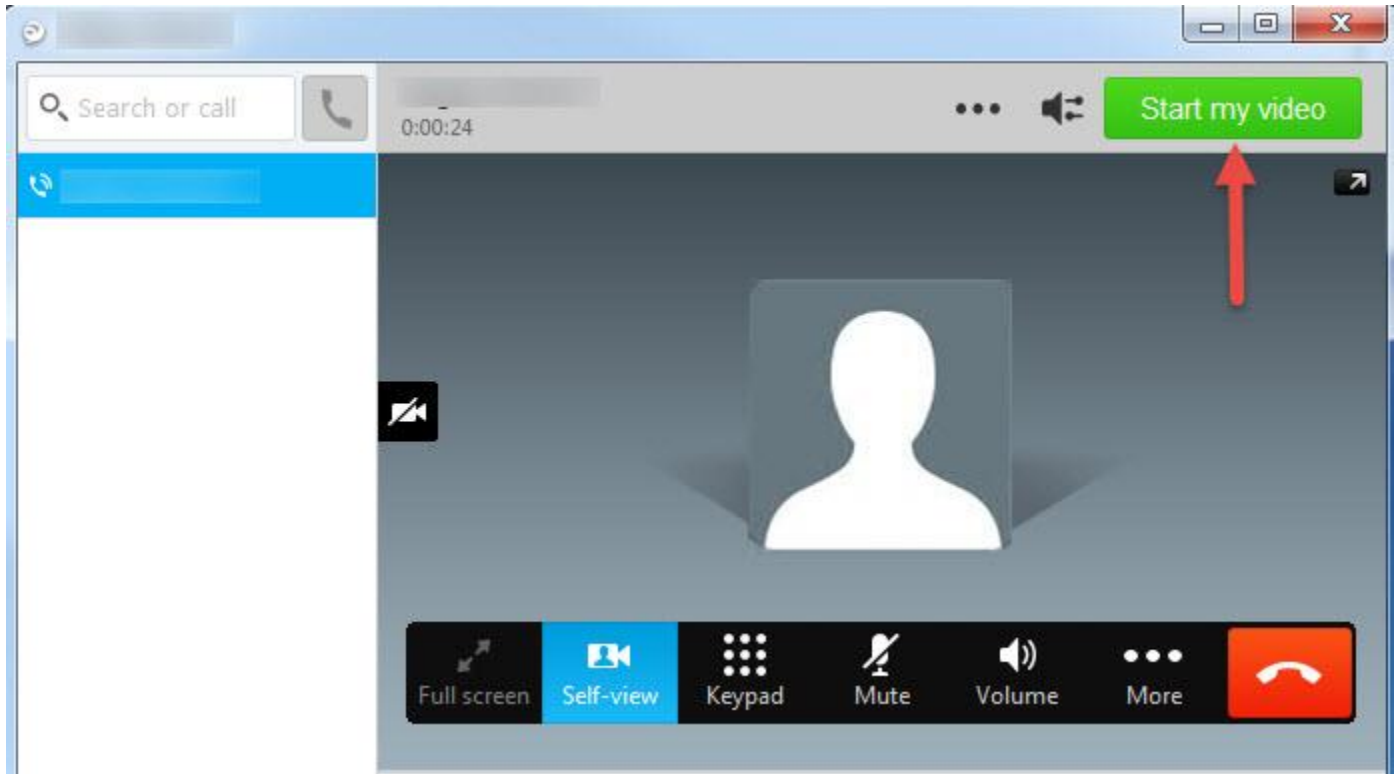
3. Click on the **Audio** option in the window. Make sure your audio device is connected and properly selected for the **Speaker and Microphone**. Click **OK** when finished.



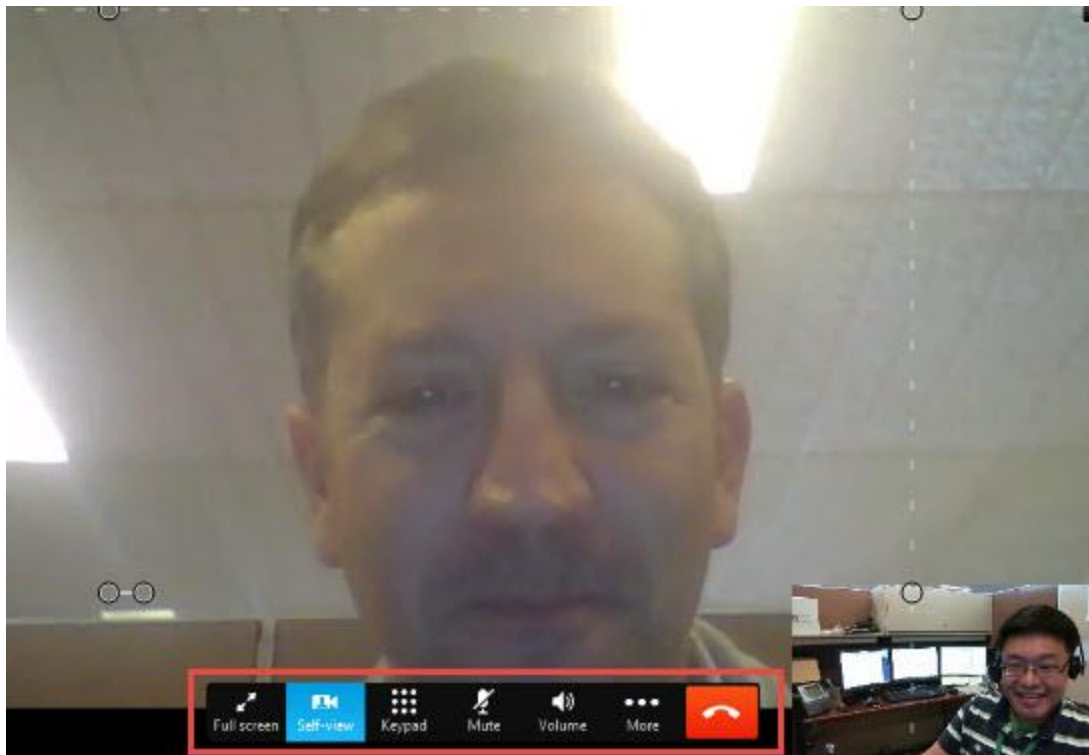
4. From the **Jabber hub** window, hover your mouse over the **contact** you want to Video call with. Click on the **Call** button.



5. If the other person cannot see your video feed, click on the **Start my video** button once connected with the person in Jabber.



6. Once the video is connected, you can use the **Work Tools Menu** to control your Video call.

7. if you are on a video call and would like to conference a third person into your video call, your video stream will be placed on hold until you disconnect the added person.

Jabber video calls can only do point-to-point. If you need more than two Jabbers videos on a video call, you will need to [Schedule a Video Bridge](#) using Outlook.
